

ORDINANCE 2017 - 5

SEWER RATES TO THE CUSTOMERS OF THE WEST UNION WATER / SEWER DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of West Union needs to make improvements to its Sanitary Sewer Collection and Treatment System, and

WHEREAS, the West Union Water / Sewer Department will need to borrow money for construction of the improvements, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined, through a rate analysis included in a Facility Plan prepared by CT Consultants, that the Sewer Operating Fund does not have sufficient revenue to pay for the improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of West Union has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and necessary to establish an increase in the sewer rates for the West Union Water / Sewer Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST UNION, OHIO:

Section 1: The Water Rates, Rules, and Regulations of the West Union Water / Sewer Department shall remain as previously established.

Section 2: This ordinance hereby supersedes any and all ordinances previously passed dealing with sewer rates for the customers, residential and commercial, inside or outside of the corporation of the Village of West Union.


Section 3: That this resolution shall be effective for the meter reading of mid-month December 2017 to mid-month January 2018, for the February 2018 billing.

Section 4: This ordinance shall increase the minimum rate by 11.25% and the overage rate by 11.25% for each of the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022.

Section 5: The water / sewer rates for the West Union Water / Sewer Department shall be as listed in the attached Exhibit A (inside corporation) and Exhibit B (outside corporation).

Section 6: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that results in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
