

VILLAGE OF WEST UNION
ORDINANCE 2022 - 7
WATER RATES TO THE CUSTOMERS OF THE
WEST UNION WATER DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of West Union needs to increase the rates to provide sufficient revenue for the increase in annual operational costs to its Water Distribution and Treatment System, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined, through a rate analysis prepared by CT Consultants, that the Water Operating Fund does not have sufficient revenue to pay for the increasing annual operational costs, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of West Union has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and necessary to establish an increase in the water rates for the West Union Water Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST UNION, OHIO:

Section 1: The Water Rates, Rules, and Regulations of the West Union Water Department shall remain as previously established.

Section 2: This ordinance hereby supersedes any and all ordinances previously passed dealing with water rates for the customers, residential and commercial, inside or outside of the corporation of the Village of West Union.

Section 3: That this resolution shall be effective for the first meter reading in January, 2023.


Section 4: This ordinance shall increase the Inside Minimum Rate by 3.00% and the Inside Overage Rate by 3.00%; and the Outside Minimum Rate by 6.00% and the Outside Overage Rate by 6.00% for the year 2023, and then the Inside rates shall be increased 3.00% and Outside Rates shall be increased 6.00% for the minimum rate and overage rate for the three (3) years of 2023 through 2025.

Section 5: The water rates for the West Union Water Department shall be as listed in the attached Exhibit A (inside corporation) and Exhibit B (outside corporation).

Section 6: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were passed in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that results in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
